### PRICING

You should price your work reasonably but allow for a 50% commission, which will be shared between Newman Galleries and the Sketch Club.

### DROPPING OFF WORK

Work will be collected at the Sketch Club on Friday May 11 (1 pm UNTIL DINNER), Friday, May 18 and Saturday, May 19, 2007 from 12 noon to 5 pm.

Entering work in this show shall imply an agreement by the artist with all conditions set forth.

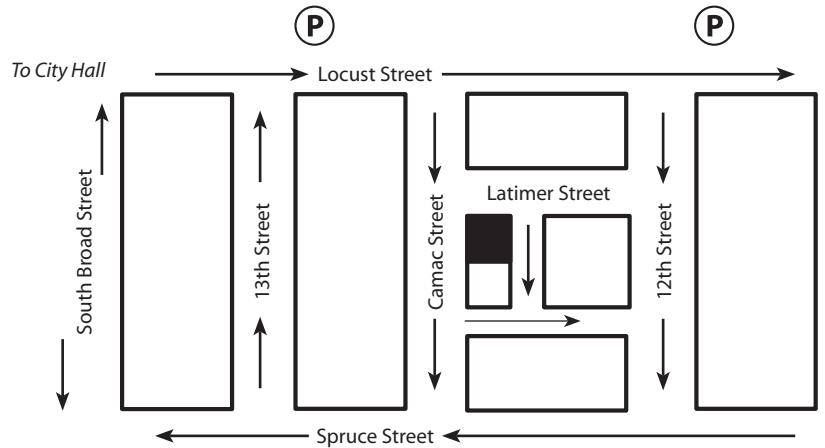
