2017 PSC Workshop Show

May 19th through June 3rd, 2017

Gallery Hours are Wednesday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday from 1 to 5pm

ENTRY: Entries are FREE. This is an UNJURIED show and will not have submissions through Entrythingy. Entries should be brought in directly to the workshop monitors or to our Gallery Manager on the specified dates below. In lieu of online entry, there will be a delivery sheet for you to fill in the corresponding information. SEE THE SIGN IN SHEET AT: https://goo.gl/LwQLgt

Submitted works may be in any medium or size. All entries must be work executed at the Philadelphia Sketch Club in a workshop, or strongly influenced by a workshop. All drawings and prints MUST have a simple frame, and/or canvas edges should be painted. All work must be ready for hanging with wires, and pastel or charcoal pieces must be covered with glass to prevent smudging.

All work MUST be signed on the front discreetly, and labeled with the name, title, medium, price, and contact information on the back.

SUBMISSIONS: You may submit up to 4 pieces. Between 2 to 4 pieces will be accepted for display. (See Works Eligible for further details.) Make sure that all of your information is accurate.

DELIVERY: May 12th $- 13^{th}$ during PSC workshops, or to our Gallery Manager. Exhibitors MUST sign in their artwork on the designated sheet.

DELIVERY DEADLINE: Saturday May 13th, 2017 @ 1-5pm

No work will be accepted after this date due to catalogue preparation and hanging.

RECEPTION: Sunday May 28th, 2017 from 2 to 4pm in the Philadelphia Sketch Club's upstairs gallery. Artists are encouraged to bring light snacks to be shared with attendees. Weather permitting, our garden will be open for all to enjoy.

PICKUP: June 4th – 7th during PSC workshops. Exhibitors are also welcome to pick up their work during our gallery hours on Wednesday, June 7th. Exhibitors MUST sign out their work on the designated sheet. **PICKUP DEADLINE: Wednesday, June 7th**, 2017


SALES: All works exhibited in the Workshop Show will be for sale. A sales commission of 25% will be charged to any sales. Please keep this in mind when pricing your artwork.
