

Focus on: Albert Van Nesse Greene

Albert Van Nesse Greene (1887-1971) is the subject of the exhibition Impressions of Life currently being held at the Gratz Gallery in Doylestown. Greene joined the Sketch Club in 1920 and took an active role in exhibitions and events at the Club. On a couple of occasions he donated a painting that was sold off to help bolster the Club's finances. Born in New York, Greene studied at the Corcoran Gallery of Art in Washington, DC, and the Art Students League in New York. He also studied at the Académie de la Grande Chaumière in Paris where he was greatly influenced by Monet and Degas. Greene later enrolled in the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts and studied with Henry McCarter and Daniel Garber. Greene's impressionist landscapes were painted in Chester and Bucks counties and the area around Washington, DC. He traveled frequently and tried to spend part of each year in France to paint and exhibit. The Gratz exhibition contains about fifty of Greene's works and is documented with an information and image filled



catalogue. One of Greene's works, a pastel of a floral arrangement, is in the Sketch Club's permanent collection.


These pieces reflect the beautiful Hungarian lace called halas and flowers and other folk culture of the Hungarian Steppes.
