**Submissions:** You can submit up to 10 works. Maximum Accepted Works Per Artist is 2.

**Works Eligible:** Submitted pieces can be 2D or 3D in any medium (including photography), and must have a theme of Flowers as the subject. All works must be offered for sale during the exhibition. Jurors will choose a maximum of 2 works submitted by any one artist for display at the exhibition. Maximum framed size is 44 inches in width including the frame. All work, including 3D, must arrive at the PSC ready to be hung, securely wired with eyehooks. Weight may not exceed 30 lbs. All 3D work should be hangable as the PSC Gallery is not able to accommodate large freestanding sculpture. Work accepted on-line that is deemed non-suitable upon delivery at the PSC will not be displayed.

**Entry Fee:**

- PSC Members: \$10 entry for first piece, \$10 additional works
- Non Members: \$20 for first piece, \$10 for additional works

**Delivery of Accepted Works:** Wed March 29th 1-5PM, Friday March 31st 1-5, and Saturday April 1<sup>st</sup> 1-3PM

**Reception:** Sunday April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023 1-3pm

**Pickup:** After reception Sun April 23<sup>rd</sup> 3-5pm 1-5pm, Wed April 26<sup>th</sup>, 1-5 pm, Friday April 28<sup>th</sup> 1-5 pm.

**ALL WORK MUST BE PICKED UP OR PICK UP DATE ARRANGED.** Any work not picked up within 60 days of the end of the exhibition will become property of the PSC.

**Prizes:** First \$300, Second \$200, and Third place \$100; Honorary Mentions and Special Awards: Best Still Life \$100, Best Landscape \$100, Best Watercolor \$100. Only one award per entrant.

**Liability:** All work will be handled with care; however, the Philadelphia Sketch Club assumes no liability for loss or damage. Any work not picked up within 60 days of the end of the exhibition will become property of the PSC.

**Sales:** The gallery is open Wednesday, and Friday thru Sunday 1-5 PM for the duration of the exhibition. A sales commission of 25% will be charged to any sales. All submitted works by an accepted artist will be shown in our online gallery and subject to sales.

Shipping of work to buyer must be handled by artist- include potential shipping in price of piece.

**Don Meyer** was a devoted Distinguished Member of the Philadelphia Sketch Club. An accomplished painter, he enthusiastically and tirelessly served the PSC in a myriad of different ways, including serving as Vice President for over 10 years, and acting as Chairman of a host of different exhibitions. A well-known artist in Philadelphia, in 2002 Don was the subject of a one-person exhibition at the Berman Museum on the campus of Ursinus College. In addition, he was the Curator for the exhibition *Surviving Ourselves*, an exhibition of the contemporary masters of the Philadelphia Sketch Club in the permanent collection of the Woodmere Art Museum. Don passed away suddenly on September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Through the generosity of his wife, Dianne Meyer, we are able to remember him and honor his legacy with the Donald C. Meyer Medal.
