**Works Eligible:** One (1) piece utilizing any 2D or 3D medium. NO size restriction (as long as it can fit up our staircase; larger than 44 inches in any dimension may not work). 2D works need to be wired for hanging. Clip frames are not allowed. Show is open to all subjects and mediums. Freestanding sculpture may not be a good choice to enter, however, as it will need to be moved regularly to accommodate workshops using the gallery space.
