Entry Information

- **Entry is by on-line submission at:** <https://sketchclub.org/enter-an-exhibition/>
- **Submissions:** You can submit up to 10 works. Maximum accepted works per artist is 2.

Works Eligible: Submitted pieces can be 2D or 3D in any medium (including photography), and must have a theme of Flowers as the subject. All works must be offered for sale during the exhibition. Jurors will choose a maximum of 2 works submitted by any one artist for display at the exhibition. Maximum framed size is 44 inches in width including the frame. All work, including 3D, must arrive at the PSC ready to be hung, securely wired with eyehooks. Weight may not exceed 30 lbs. All 3D work should be hangable as the PSC Gallery is not able to accommodate large freestanding sculpture. Work accepted on-line that is deemed non-suitable upon delivery at the PSC will not be displayed. Please include shipping cost in price. The PSC takes a 25% commission for all sales. All work must be original and not previously shown at the PSC.

- **Entry Fee:**
 - PSC Members: \$10 for first piece, \$10 for each additional works
 - Non Members: \$25 for first piece, \$10 for each additional works
