Please fill in all fields and only edit your own submission. Work that has not been signed in will not be displayed.

- **Submissions:** You can submit up to 2 works per artist.

Works Eligible: This is a FREE, NON-JURIED exhibition for traditional and non-traditional small to medium works marked at an accessible price point. Submitted pieces can be 2D or 3D in any medium, any subject matter, **no larger than 24" in any dimension, framed and wired to hang.** All work, including 3D, must arrive at the PSC ready to be hung, securely wired with eyehooks (we cannot accommodate large freestanding sculpture). Weight may not exceed 30 lbs. All work must be offered for sale. All work must be original and not previously shown at the PSC.

- **Deadline for on-line submissions:** 11:59 PM Sunday, October 20th
- **Notification of acceptance:** All works entered in the Sign Up Sheet that are deemed suitable to hang upon drop-off will be accepted.
- **Delivery:** Wednesday, October 30th 1-5 PM; Friday, November 1st 1-5 PM; Saturday, November 2nd 1-3 PM
- **Pick Up:** Sunday, December 15th 1-3 PM; Wednesday, December 18th 1-5 PM; Friday, December 20th 1-5 PM; Saturday, December 21st 1-3 PM
 - **Work cannot be stored at the club and must be picked up, or a pick up date arranged at a later time. Work left for more than 30 days after the end of an exhibition becomes property of the PSC.**
- **Reception:** Sunday, November 10th 1-3 PM. We encourage shareable snacks brought to the event!
