Entry Information

- **Entry is by on-line submission:** <https://www.entrythingy.com/d=sketchclub.org - dashboard>
- **Submissions:** This is an **open, juried show for works on paper**. You may submit up to 10 works. Maximum accepted works per artist is 2.

Works Eligible: Any 2-dimensional works on paper utilizing watercolor, oil, gouache, casein, acrylics, inks, printing, graphite, etching, charcoal, pastel, collage, pencil, mixed media, and others. Digital art is allowed, but not photography or digitally edited photographs. **All works MUST be framed and wired to hang.** Works may not exceed 40" in any dimension, including frame. All work, including 3D, must arrive at the PSC ready to be hung, securely wired with eyehooks (we cannot accommodate large freestanding sculpture). Weight may not exceed 30 lbs. **All work must be offered for sale.** The PSC takes a 25% commission on all sales. All work must be original and not previously shown at the PSC. Please include potential shipping cost in price. Works created using AI are not eligible in any PSC exhibition.

Entry Fees:

- PSC Members: \$10 for first piece, \$10 for each additional work
- Non-Members: \$25 for first piece, \$10 for each additional work

- **Deadline for on-line submissions:** 11:59 PM Friday, December 12th
- **Notification of acceptance:** Emails sent week of Tuesday, December 16th. Check your spam!
- **Delivery:** Wednesday, December 31st 1-5 PM; Friday, January 2nd 1-5 PM; Saturday, January 3rd 1-3 PM (If shipping artwork, view PSC Shipping Terms and Conditions on our website).
- **Pick Up:** Sunday, January 25th 1-3 PM; Wednesday, January 28th 1-5 PM; Friday, January 30th 1-5 PM
 - **Work cannot be stored at the club and must be picked up, or a pick up date arranged at a later time. Any work not picked up more than 30 days after the end of an exhibition becomes property of the PSC.**
- **Reception:** Sunday, January 11th, **1-3 PM**. Shareable snacks are encouraged and appreciated!

Awards: First, Second, and Third place prizes will be check awards with Contemporary Sketch Club Medals and certificates. At least three Honorable Mentions will be awarded. Juror(s) will select works for exhibition; prizes are awarded after works are delivered. Awards are handed out at the Reception at 2:00 PM.
