Entry Information:

- **Entry is by on-line submission:** [Philadelphia Sketch Club - Calls](#)
- **Submissions:** This is an **open, juried show for illustrative works**. **Traditional mediums are highly encouraged**; both traditional and digital illustrations are eligible. You may submit up to 10 works. Maximum accepted works per artist is 2.

Works Eligible: Any work of illustration, including sequential, editorial, self-published, children's book, advertising and institutional, self-promotional and unpublished, traditional or digital media. Student entries are strongly encouraged. **Works created using AI are not eligible in any PSC exhibition. All works MUST be framed and wired to hang.** Works may not exceed 40" in any dimension, including frame. All work, including 3D, must arrive at the PSC ready to be hung, securely wired with eyehooks (we cannot accommodate large freestanding sculpture). Weight may not exceed 30 lbs. **All work must be offered for sale.** The PSC takes a 25% commission on all sales. All work must be original and not previously shown at the PSC. Please include potential shipping cost in price. Work accepted on-line that is deemed non-suitable upon delivery at the PSC will not be displayed.

Entry Fees:

- Students & PSC Members: \$5 for first piece, \$10 for each additional work
- Non-Members: \$20 for first piece, \$10 for each additional work

Important Dates:

- **Deadline for on-line submissions:** 11:59 PM Friday, March 13th, 2026.
- **Notification of acceptance:** Emails sent week of Tuesday, March 17th. Check your spam!
- **Delivery:** Sunday, March 29th 1-3 PM; Wednesday, April 1st 1-5 PM; Friday, April 3rd 1-5 PM (If shipping artwork, view PSC Shipping Terms and Conditions on our website).
- **Pick Up:** Sunday, April 26th 1-3 PM; Wednesday, April 29th 1-5 PM; Friday, May 1st 1-5 PM

Work **cannot** be stored at the club and must be picked up, or a pickup date arranged at a later time. Any work not picked up more than **30 days** after the end of an exhibition becomes property of the PSC.

- **Reception:** Sunday, April 12th, **1-3 PM**. Shareable snacks are encouraged and appreciated!

Awards, Chair, and Juror:

Awards: First, Second, and Third place awards will be selected for a Student Category and a Professional Category. Prizes are check awards with Contemporary Sketch Club Medals and certificates. At least three Honorable Mentions will be awarded for each Category. Juror(s) will select works for exhibition; prizes are awarded after works are delivered. Awards are handed out at the Reception at 2:00 PM.
