- **Submissions & Theme:** *Somewhere I’ve Been* is an open, juried exhibition exploring travel, place, and personal geography. You may submit up to 10 works. Maximum accepted works per artist is 2.

We welcome artwork inspired by:

- Travel & journeys
- Landscapes & environments
- Memory & identity tied to a place
- Vacation or escape
- Everyday spaces and “stay-cations”

Works Eligible: Submitted pieces may be 2D or 3D in any medium and must explore the theme of “Somewhere I’ve Been”. **All works MUST wired to hang;** frames are preferred, but wrapped canvas is acceptable. Works may not exceed 40” in any dimension, including frames. All work, including 3D, must arrive at the PSC ready to be hung, securely wired with eyehooks (we cannot accommodate large freestanding sculpture). Weight may not exceed 30 lbs. All work must be offered for sale. The PSC takes a 25% commission on all sales. All work must be original and not previously shown at the PSC. Please include potential shipping cost in price. Works created using AI are not eligible in any PSC exhibition. Works deemed unsuitable upon delivery will not be displayed.

Entry Fees:

- PSC Members: \$10 for first piece, \$10 for each additional work
- Non-Members: \$20 for first piece, \$10 for each additional work

- **Deadline for on-line submissions:** 11:59 PM Friday, May 15th.
- **Notification of acceptance:** Emails sent week of Tuesday, May 19th. Check your spam!
- **Delivery:** Sunday, May 31st 1-3 PM; Wednesday, June 3rd 1-5 PM; Friday, June 5th 1-5 PM (If shipping artwork, view PSC Shipping Terms and Conditions on our website).
- **Pick Up (Adjusted for July 4th):** Sunday, June 28th 1-3 PM; Monday, June 29th 1-5 PM; Wednesday, July 1st 1-5 PM

Work **cannot** be stored at the club and must be picked up, or a pick up date arranged at a later time. Any work not picked up more than 30 days after the end of an exhibition becomes property of the PSC.

- **Reception:** Sunday, June 14th, 1-3 PM. Shareable snacks are encouraged and appreciated!

Awards, Chair, and Juror

Awards: First, Second, and Third place prizes will be check awards with Contemporary Sketch Club Medals and certificates. At least three Honorable Mentions will be awarded. Juror(s) will select works for exhibition; prizes are awarded after works are delivered. Awards presented at the Reception at 2:00 PM.
